## DROP-OFF & PICK UP

- At this time, the lobby will remain closed to ensure physical distancing.
- Please arrive only 5 minutes before scheduled class start. Early students will not be permitted.
- Masks are required for dancers (ages 5+), parents and staff in all common areas.
- **Students ages 4 and under: One parent\*** may accompany their child into the lobby area and wait with them on their designated waiting spot. Once your child is settled, parents are required to wait outside the studio.
- **Students ages 5 and up:** May be dropped off at the EDC entrance inside of the mall. A staff member will direct them to their waiting spot. *Please be mindful of keeping a distance of 2 metres at all times in the mall common area.*
- During class, parents may wait in their vehicles or leave and return to pick up their child at the end of class in the mall common area. Please be on time for pick up to allow us to maintain distancing requirements.
- If your child needs you during class we will phone you. A staff member will be onsite in the lobby at all times.
- Students should come dressed for class and use the restroom before leaving home. Studio restrooms will be open for emergencies only.

***\*As per MB public health order, parent entering the studio must be able to provide proof of double vaccination and government issued ID.***

## PERSONAL BELONGINGS

- The change rooms will remain closed at this time. Students may bring one dance bag into class with them and they will receive a sanitized bin that will hold all their personal items. This bin will stay in their assigned room the entire class. Please consider wearing slip-on footwear.
- Students should bring a labeled bottled water from home. Water will be available for purchase for \$1.00.
- Dancers are not permitted to change between classes. Please come dressed for all your classes using appropriate layers if necessary.

At this time, any 1 hour class will be reduced to 55 minutes in length to allow for studio sanitation and to allow for physical distancing during class change.

## SANITIZATION & SAFETY

- All children must be self-screened at home prior to coming to the studio. Please do not send your child to dance if they are sick or showing any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Upon arrival students will sanitize hands before entering the studio.
- At this time, masks are required for students and any parents\* entering the studio.
- Studio barres and high-touch areas will be sanitized between each class.
- Deep cleanings of the entire facility will take place daily including fogging of the entire facility using a disinfectant.
- The studio is equipped with an outside air exchanger that will run at all times to ensure adequate fresh air intake throughout the studios.
- Curricular and syllabus adjustments will be in place to ensure students limit contact throughout the class.
- Students will maintain physical distancing in studios through the use of floor markings.

***\*As per MB public health order, parent entering the studio must be able to provide proof of double vaccination and government issued ID.***

## EMPLOYEE SAFETY

- All employees will be screened for symptoms and have their temperature checked prior to arrival into the studio.
- All instructors will be required to wash hands/sanitize before and after each class.
- All staff will continue to wear face masks.
- Employees will maintain physical distance from other employees and students in the lobby areas and wherever possible in the dance studios while teaching.
